1 REVIEW PROCEDURE

The reviews were double-blind Each submission was examined by 3 reviewer(s) independently.

The conference submission management system was Nutral.id

Editor in Chief will assign the manuscript to Managing Editor for further handling. The Managing Editor will request at least three scientists to review the research article manuscript. All manuscripts are subject to double-blind peer-review, the identity of the reviewer is hidden from the author, as well as the identity of the author is hidden from the reviewer during the review process to meet academic excellence standards. Authors of a rejected submission were given the opportunity to revise and resubmit after addressing the reviewers' comments. The acceptance or rejection of a revised manuscript was final.

2 QUALITY CRITERIA

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions Pertinence of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference;

1. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
2. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
3. Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
4. Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher. We also do a plagiarism check using tools.
