1. PEER REVIEW PROCESS

All articles submitted to the journal are *subject to strict, editorial review and double-blind peer review*. We send articles to the subject experts and take their objective opinion on the quality of content, article structure and language correctness. All manuscripts are reviewed in fairness based on the intellectual content of the paper regardless of gender, race, ethnicity, religion, citizenry nor political values of the author(s).

Any observed conflict of interest during the review process must be communicated to the Editor

Final decision of articles acceptance will be made by Editors according to reviewers comments. Publication of accepted articles including the sequence of published articles will be made by Editor in Chief by considering sequence of accepted date and geographical distribution of authors as well as thematic issue.

The following are the most common decisions:

- Accept without any changes (acceptance): the journal will publish the paper in its original form;
- 2) Accept with minor revisions (acceptance): the journal will publish the paper and asks the author to make small corrections;
- Accept after major revisions (conditional acceptance): the journal will publish the paper provided the authors make the changes suggested by the reviewers and/or editors;
- 4) Revise and resubmit (conditional rejection): the journal is willing to reconsider the paper in another round of decision making after the authors make major changes;

Reject the paper (outright rejection): the journal will not publish the paper or reconsider it even if the authors make major revisions;

All information pertaining to the manuscript is kept confidential. Any information that may be the reason for the rejection of publication of a manuscript must be communicated to the Editor.

2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions. Pertinence of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference;

- 1. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
- 2. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
- Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
- 4. Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher by use turnitin application.
