In the continuous optimization of functions at the same time, the MySQL database in terms of performance is also constantly soaring, MySQL database storage space is very sufficient. MySQL database has a lot of security precautions to protect the security of system data<sup>[8]</sup>.

This system mainly has three roles: administrator, teacher and student. Administrators can log in to the system for system management, file management, certificate management, card cancellation management, student card cancellation management, school application management, book lending management, accommodation information management, funding information management and league organization relationship management. Students can initiate an application to leave school, the teacher checks the information, and the administrator of each department can approve it. 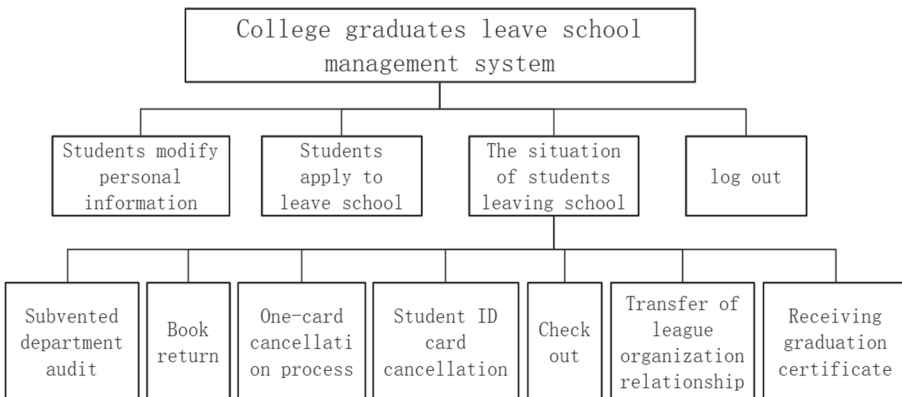
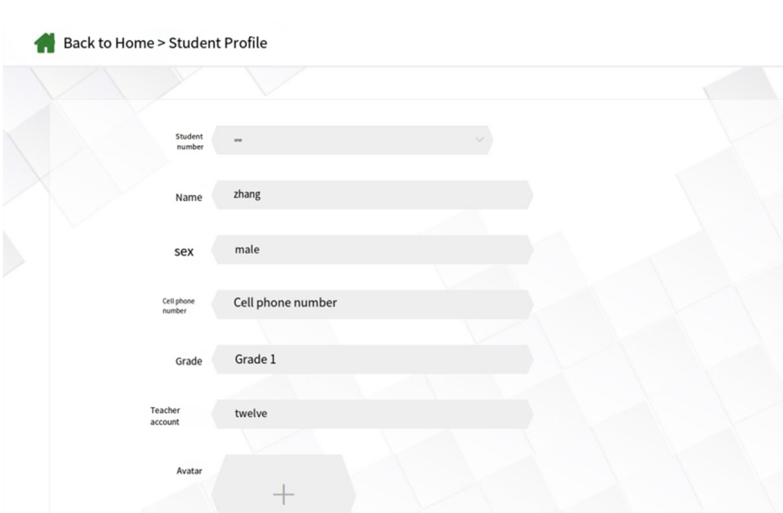


Fig. 1. System Specific Function Module Diagram

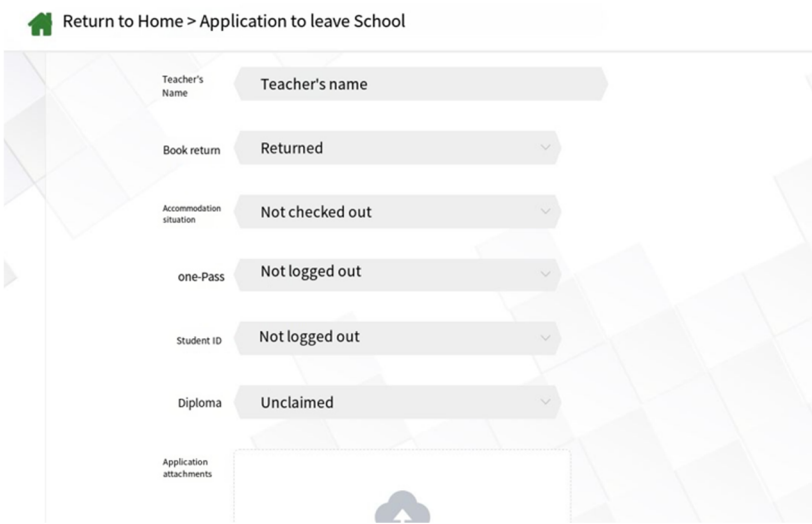


Fig. 3. Launch the Exit Application Module Display Chart

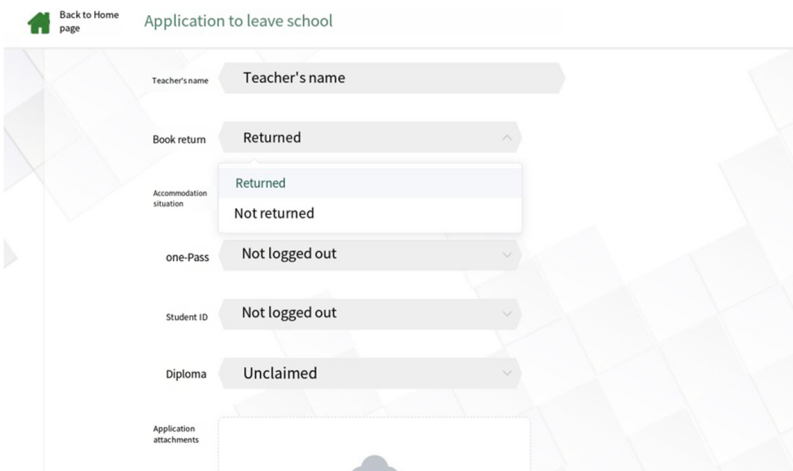


Fig. 4. Leave Application Processing Overview Map

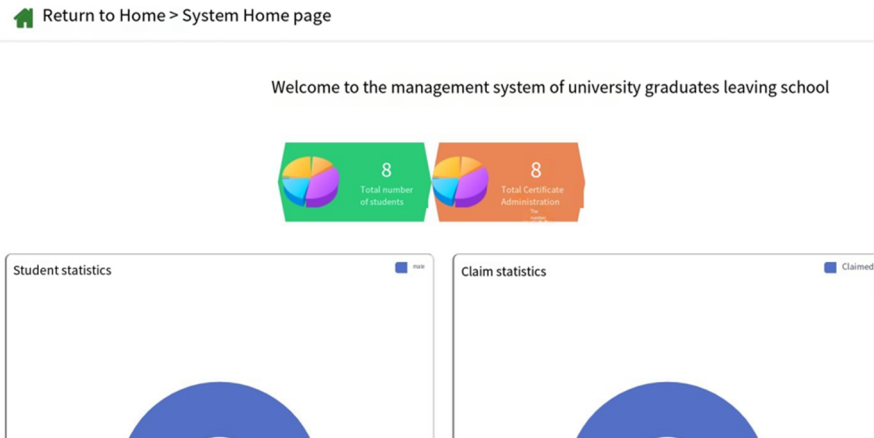


Fig. 5. School Leaving Statistics Chart
