

# The Role of Digital Humanities for Teaching and Learning Indigenous Psychology

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**Abstract.** The purpose of this research is to describe and analyze the role of digital humanities data in teaching and learning Indigenous Psychology in higher education. However, the availability of data and information about basic materials and relevant learning materials is sometimes not provided sufficiently. 


Fig. 1. Data from Google search engine related to Indigenous Psychology.




Fig. 2. data related to indigenous psychology from YouTube.

Materials that can be developed in an effort to introduce digital humanities pedagogy can be done by training, teaching in class, and providing documents in online form and how to use online/electronic documents become necessary to learn so that students get more adequate insight and knowledge.
