All of the articles in this proceedings volume have been presented at the *1st Widyatama International Conference on Management, Social Science and Humanities (WICo-SSH) 2024* during 23-24 October 2024 in Widyatama University, Bandung, West Java, Indonesia. These articles have been peer reviewed by the members of the Scientific Committee and approved by the Editor-in-Chief, who affirms that this document is a truthful description of the conference's review process.

1. REVIEW PROCEDURE

The reviews were *double-blind*. Each submission was examined by *at least 2* reviewer(s) independently.

The conference submission management system was Edas.

The submissions were first screened for generic quality and suitableness. After the initial screening, they were sent for peer review by matching each paper's topic with the reviewers' expertise, taking into account any competing interests. A paper could only be considered for acceptance if it had received favourable recommendations from the two reviewers

Authors of a rejected submission were given the opportunity to revise and resubmit after addressing the reviewers' comments. The acceptance or rejection of a revised manuscript was final.

2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions:

- 1. Novelty and Originality: Uniqueness and originality in the presented paper;
- 2. Technical Sound: Technical content and scientific rigour;

 - 3. Quality: Quality of Presentation of papers, including presentation of significant work and results:
 - 4. Literature: Adequacy of references to literature;
 - 5. Contribution: Potential impact and contribution;
 - 6. Recommended to Publish in Atlantis Press Conference Series: Would you like to recommend this paper to be submitted to Atlantis Press Conference Series after author had present the paper.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher.
