



# Role-Playing to Improve German Speaking Skills

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**Abstract.** This research explores the effectiveness of role-playing as a method to enhance German speaking skills. Considering the challenges faced by learners in mastering the German language, such as complex grammatical structures and difficult pronunciation, this research aims to evaluate how role-playing can help overcome these difficulties and improve practical speaking skills. Through an experimental design with a control group and an experimental group, as well as the collection of qualitative data from observations and in-depth interviews, this study demonstrates that role-playing significantly enhances speaking fluency, confidence, and vocabulary mastery. However, despite the positive results, it is of paramount importance to note some constraints faced during the research, such as differences in initial skill levels among participants and challenges in simulating highly diverse situations. Therefore, further evaluation and adjustment of methods may be necessary to address these shortcomings and maximize the benefits of role-playing in German language teaching. Overall, the results of this study provide strong support for the integration of role-playing in language teaching curricula, with the potential to significantly enhance speaking skills.

This research shows that role-playing is an effective method for improving German speaking skills. Diversifying the situation will ensure that participants gain a broad and relevant experience. Second, it is important to provide constructive and structured feedback after each role-playing session, to help participants understand their strengths and areas that need improvement in their speaking skills. This feedback will support ongoing learning and assist participants in overcoming the challenges they face. Third, the integration of role-playing should be combined with other teaching methods

to create a balanced and comprehensive approach. Traditional methods that teach grammar and vocabulary are still important, but they should be combined with situational practice for optimal results. Lastly, further research is needed to explore how role-playing can be applied in various contexts and with different groups of participants, including those with varying levels of language proficiency. This research can provide additional insights into how this method can be adapted and optimized to meet the diverse needs of learners.

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
